## TIPS

- Do you want to teach your child many new words? Tell them what you are doing when you are together, for example, when you are shopping. Your child learns a lot during daily activities, as long as you say the words.
- Small children like to look at pictures. Talk about them together:
  - What pictures do you see?
  - What can the children already point out?
  - What can they already say themselves?
- Look through a picture book together. Tell stories about what you see.
- Children always enjoy playing games together. Talk about what happens during the game.
- Singing songs also teaches your child a lot.
- Do you want to teach your child about the world? Then tell or read stories to them.

If your child knows your mother tongue well, it will be easier for them to learn a new language!

- Would you like to learn Dutch together? Then look at picture dictionaries. These are books with pictures and words
- Watch and listen to a digital book together. The Dutch text is read aloud, so you can hear the correct pronunciation immediately.
